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Alcohol



Clear-headed driving saves lives. When you're sober, your reactions are sharp, judgment is sound, and you protect yourself and others on the road.

1 Understanding alcohol:

- Alcohol is a central nervous system depressant.
- It slows reaction times and impairs judgment.
- Caffeinated drinks, water, or other remedies won't eliminate alcohol intoxication.

2 Pre-duty and on duty use:

- Avoid alcohol at least four hours before going on duty.
- Zero alcohol concentration while on duty.

3 No alcohol in your vehicle:

 Never have alcohol in your commercial motor vehicle (CMV) while on duty.

4 Alcohol concentration levels:

- Concentrations of 0.02 or greater but less than 0.04 lead to a minimum 24-hour relief from duty.
- 0.04 or higher concentration is considered a positive alcohol test.
- This limit applies when driving a CMV, not a personal vehicle.

5 Consequences:

- Treatment and additional testing are required for a 0.04 level.
- If arrested, operating a CMV at this level can result in suspension for one year.
